Quick & Easy Recipes



7 c. cooked chicken, shredded into pieces

2 cans (10 3/4 oz) cream of chicken s oup, undi I uted

1 16-oz. container sour cream

1-2 T. poppy seeds

2 jars Green Giant sliced mushrooms, drained

1/2 c. butter, melted

2 c. Ritz crackers, crushed

Cooked rice

Mix soups, sour cream, mushrooms, poppy seeds, and chicken together.



Add about half of the buttered crumb mixture into the chicken mixture. Stir well. Pour over a bed of cooked rice placed in a 9 x 13 greased casserole dish. Sprinkle the remaining crumb mixture on top of the casserole. (1 pkg of slivered almonds may be added to this crumb topping, if desired). Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.
